Reflections: Park Social Temporary Art Project - L. Bullock, PhD, C.G. Miller, & Art Builds

Presentation of art project that was at the Cove and discussion of if and where to exhibit in The Shores. Park Social was designed to commission local artists to produce thought-provoking, innovative projects for the City's Park system.

Vending Ordinance & The Shores - S. Hadley

Status with City & actions for CA Coastal Commission hearing

Boardwalk at Kellogg Park has been deemed high pedestrian area and is off limits to vendors year round. While waiting Coastal Commission approval of new law, LaCava has asked the Mayor to enforce all existing laws such as ADA, food and health. Rangers successfully enforced many items over July 4th weekend.

Shores Outside Dining Status -P. Wise

Status at City & CA Coastal Commission plus Insurance coverage needed
The restaurants on the south side of Ave de la Playa are now required to move their outdoor dining to no more than 6 feet from curb. Some north side stay as is, other need to move to no more than 6 feet from the curb.
La Jolla Shores Business Association got insurance and should get permit tomorrow. Enabled “activation” that will keep traffic off of street from 8am to 11pm, by establishing an art exhibit thru the end of 2022.

PRESENTATION

Air Quality Issues in LJ Shores - M. Meza

Overview of air quality, monitoring & oversight by SD County Air Pollution Control Dist.

Andi compared air quality data from La Jolla Shores (10.7) and Logan Heights (8.9)

Melina explained the 6 key program areas: Air Quality monitoring, Planning and rule development, Engineering, Compliance, Grants and incentives, and Environmental justice.

Their closest monitor is in Kearny Mesa, so they don't see the air pollution seen at the beach by the Purple Air private monitors. The beach pollution is much worse than the inland areas, per Purple Monitors, but they don't have plans to add more official monitors at the beach at this time. However, she took this suggestion under advisement.
